WHEN: March 12—14, 2010 - Registration will open up on FRIDAY from 7:00-8:15—make sure to eat dinner before you arrive. Ignite will conclude by noon on SUNDAY—Lunch will be on your own.

DEADLINE for REGISTRATION: & COST: \$85 (\$65 Sponsors) postmarked by Mar. 1, 2010 (there will be an **\$11 late fee** for all registrations **postmarked after Mar. 1 & must be approved** first by contacting pASTOR pETE). Please help us by getting your student and/or sponsor registrations to us as quickly as possible. It is our desire to accommodate all who register. However, space is limited so get your **REGISTRATION IN EARLY** to reserve your spot. Registrations will be processed in the order that they were received. Thanks for your help and cooperation on this. Again, all registrations after Monday, March 1st must be approved (contact pASTOR pETE - NOTE: This is to ensure accommodations and food).

There will also be some activities that they can participate in that will have an additional cost: Paintball—\$15; and the EDGE Zip line—\$5 (over 2,000 ft.); and the Low Ropes Course—\$5 (recommended for youth groups, NOT individuals. 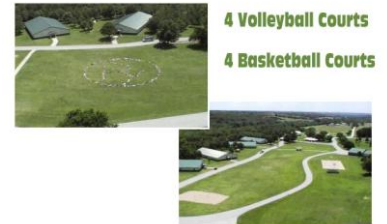

For your information, we expect each student to conform to the following rules of conduct:
